

## **D & A completes clean up contract for Orlando Fire Station No. 1**

Longwood, Fla., December 7, 2009 — D & A Building Services Inc., a leading facility maintenance provider, has completed its contract with Wharton-Smith Inc. for construction clean-up services for Orlando Fire Station No. 1, a 59,000-square-foot facility. Under the scope of its contract, D & A dusted, wiped down or vacuumed every surface of the building's interior including air conditioning vents, fire alarm fixtures, and cleaned the windows inside and out.

Wharton-Smith Inc., Sanford, Fla., led the design-build team as the contractor. Schweizer-Waldorff Architect Inc., New Smyrna Beach, Fla., provided architecture. The Orlando, Fla., office of GAI Consultants Inc. provided planning, structural and civil engineering and landscape architecture. John J. Christie Associates of Florida Inc., Winter Park, Fla., provided mechanical, electrical and fire protection and communications engineering.

The new \$17 million fire station, the largest in the southeast, has 110-beds and fourteen apparatus bays. The Orlando Fire Department will also house its administrative and command divisions in offices on the upper levels of the new building. The City of Orlando has applied for LEED Gold certification for this facility through the U.S. Green Building Council.
